Dear Parents,

We wish all our students and their families a safe and restful 'Spring Break'. School will resume on Sunday, 11th April 2021. We have completed Term 2 assessments and now are looking forward to a successful Term 3. We hope to see our students well rested and ready for the Term 3.

CURRICULUM

Our focus for the month of April in:

English

We will continue with Unit 9. In this learners have the opportunity to read a fantasy story set in space, and to write their own fantasy story using the five-stage structure. They will also compare and contrast two poems about imaginary creatures, and write a detailed description of a setting, as well as writing their own non rhyming poem about a mythical creature. They will answer comprehension questions, practise their Listening and speaking skills by making a presentation and acting out an alternative ending to a story, revise how to write and punctuate direct speech, and explore a range of spelling patterns. They also identify homonym pairs and learn to use meaning to help them decide which word of a pair to use.

We will begin to look at Unit 8. In this unit, learners will read a playscript version of the musical story Peter and the Wolf, and also read and compare a story and a playscript about a real-life dilemma.

Reading:

- Reading fluently with correct pronunciation and proper intonation.
- Use knowledge of punctuation and grammar to read with fluency, understanding and expression;
- Retell or paraphrase events from the text in response to questions;

Grammar:

- Use a range of end-of-sentence punctuation with accuracy;
- Use a wider variety of connectives in an increasing range of sentences;
- Experiment with varying tenses within texts, e.g. in dialogue;
- Investigate past and present tenses and future forms of verbs;
- Use of commas to show embedded clause.
- Spelling homonym pairs and understanding their meaning.

Writing:

- Planning and writing a fantasy fiction.
