Online Learning has been taking place successfully. Final assessment will take place at school. Students are expected to attend the days when they have their final assessments on time. Learning outcomes and term 3 revision papers have been shared and they can be found on Teams.

CURRICULUM

Our focus for the month of June in:

English

Revision for Final assessments.

We will start Unit 7 and look at a type of reference text: alphabetically organized encyclopaedias. Learners will read extracts from an encyclopaedia about inventions. They will answer comprehension questions based on the model texts they have read. The unit offers opportunities to explore alphabetical order, revise end-of-sentence punctuation and look at past, present and future tenses in a range of different types of sentences.

Reading:

- Reading fluently with correct pronunciation and proper intonation.
- Use knowledge of punctuation and grammar to read with fluency, understanding and expression;
- Retell or paraphrase events from the text in response to questions;

Grammar:

- Use a range of end-of-sentence punctuation with accuracy;
- Use a wider variety of connectives in an increasing range of sentences;
- Experiment with varying tenses within texts, e.g. in dialogue;
- Investigate past and present tenses and future forms of verbs;
- Use of commas in sentences.
- Use powerful verbs and adverbs in writing.
- Revise alphabetical order, and apply it when using dictionaries.

Writing:

- Summarising a text.

Math

In Math, during the month, we will be looking at revising for the final assessment. We will review Unit 9 and recap topics done during the year.

- Review length, mass and capacity

In Science, during the month we will be revising for the final assessment. We will recap important concepts done during the year.
